### Professional Summary

- As superintendent, Brad controls the day to day operations in the field and on the job sites. His principal duties include properly scheduling the work of multiple crews, rented equipment and subcontractors to achieve maximum production in the safest manner; along with maintaining a good relationship with inspectors, architects, owners, subcontractors and other key personnel. Prior to the start of any project, he is responsible for creating a site-specific safety plan, and during the course of the construction process he is directly responsible for the management of anyone on site.

### Representative Projects

- **CHURCH OF THE APOSTLES** - United Restoration was selected as the restoration contractor to alleviate construction deficiencies that were plaguing the building since its construction. The scope of work included the creation of masonry control joints, installation of silicone sealants at dissimilar materials, and a general cleaning and the application of a penetrating sealer.  
Project Value - \$1,877,500
- **TWO CAPITOL SQUARE** - United Restoration was contracted to remove, restore, and reinstall over 600 - 4" Thick Marble Cladding pieces of the Historic Department of Transportation Building in Downtown Atlanta. The project also required the design and implementation of the structural attachments of the reinstalled pieces. All marble joints were finished with Dow Corning's 756 Structural Silicone Sealant.  
Project Value - \$890,000
- **Decatur Renaissance** - United Restoration was given the task of removing the entire stucco façade of an existing condominium building. The removal included everything down to the exterior studs prior to the installation of new exterior Densglass, new vapor permeable waterproofing, new flashings and details, and ultimately the new stucco façade. All units of the condo were occupied during the restoration project, so communication and protection were key elements of the project.
