Professional Summary

- As Operations Manager at United Restoration and Preservation, Wes oversees all aspects of specialty restoration projects - from business development and project estimation to management and contract closeouts. - **CHURCH OF THE APOSTLES** - United Restoration was selected as the restoration contractor to alleviate construction deficiencies that were plaguing the building since its construction. The scope of work included: creation of masonry control joints, installation of silicone sealants at dissimilar materials, general cleaning, and the application of a penetrating sealer
Project Value - \$1,877,500
- **VA DECATUR HOSPITAL** - URP was selected to perform critical façade repairs to address hazardous conditions caused by inadequate brick veneer anchoring and undersized or missing expansion joints. The scope of work included shelf angle repair and replacement, installation of through-wall flashings, damaged brick replacement, full replacement of exterior sealant joints, installation of helical masonry anchors, and tuck-pointing. Work was performed from suspended scaffolding and coordinated daily to accommodate ongoing medical operations and surgical schedules.
Project Value - \$4,498,800
- **GARDEN THEATER** - United Restoration was selected to perform a comprehensive façade repair of the historic 1917 Beaux-Arts style Garden Theater. The scope of work included terra cotta repointing, sealant replacement, spall repairs, and glazing restoration. The parapet and water table were dismantled and rebuilt, including the top six courses of terra cotta on the east façade, with a new CMU backup wall galvanized steel support structure. A total of 286 new terra cotta units were installed, and the façade was cleaned in accordance with historic preservation standards.
Project Value - \$1,172,000
