### Professional Summary

- As superintendent, Rodney controls the day to day operations in the field and on the job sites. His principal duties include properly scheduling the work of multiple crews, rented equipment and subcontractors to achieve maximum production in the safest manner. Duties also include maintaining a good relationship with inspectors, architects, owners, subcontractors, and the other key personnel. Prior to the start of any project, Rodney is responsible for creating site-specific safety plan. He is directly responsible for the management of the site and anyone present.

### Representative Projects

- **STANTON HALL** - IN conjunction with a local architect and historical conservationist, URP repaired historical lime stucco, repaired structural deficiencies at the cornices and rebuilt the mass masonry parapet. Additionally, URP completed stucco repairs at the grand entrance fluted columns and soffits.  
Project Value - \$596,000
- **DIXIE BREWERY** - Large scale masonry restoration on the iconic former brewery in New Orleans. The work included repointing, window steel header flashings, creation of solid masonry wall openings, façade cleaning, parapet reconstruction, and installation of blast reinforcement steel at exterior walls.  
Project Value - \$6,450,000
- **JACKSON BARRACKS** - Complete exterior restoration of 14 historic residences location on the current National Guard Base in New Orleans. Work entailed 100% repointing, replacement of over 40,000 bricks, and façade cleaning. Work was performed per guidelines administered by FEMA/NPS Brief 2/SHPO.  
Project Value - \$3,077,000
- **LUSHER HIGH SCHOOL** - A historical masonry high school, found in the heart of New Orleans's Garden District, Lusher High School suffered from deferred maintenance and structural masonry failures. By providing the owner and architect with a design-build solution, URP was able to present a time and cost saving solution. Repairs included masonry grout injection, tuck-pointing, flashing, still replacement, and window restoration.  
Project Value - \$2,800,000
